Cathedral Close, Exeter, EX1 1HS**

Itinerary, approximate timings & distances:

- 11.30 am Explore the Cathedral Close & the Roman City Wall. Go down to Quayside. ($\frac{1}{2}$ mile) (There will not be time to visit the inside of the cathedral.)
- 12.30 pm Visit the Custom House Visitor Centre. (Video show available)
- 1.00 - 2.00 LUNCH. (There are several cafés near the Custom House)
- 2.00 - 4.00 Walking Tour of the City including the Medieval Bridge, the House that Moved, Stepcote Hill, Fore Street, High Street, the Guildhall, Gandy Street and the Royal Albert Memorial Museum. (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles)
- 4.00 Tour ends. You may wish to visit the Museum (tea available).
- 5.00 For those who wish, Chris and David will show the way back to Paris Street bus stop via Rougemont Castle with its Norman keep. ($\frac{1}{2}$ mile)

Please make your own transport arrangements to Exeter

Car sharing is the best option. Exit the M5 at Junction 29 and drive to the Honiton Road Park and Ride about half a mile towards the city. Park free and take the Red Bus to the final stop (Paris Street) - free to bus pass-holders. Make your way to the Cathedral.
